4. implement a high-quality post-secondary readiness program that prepares students for life, work, and education/training after high school.

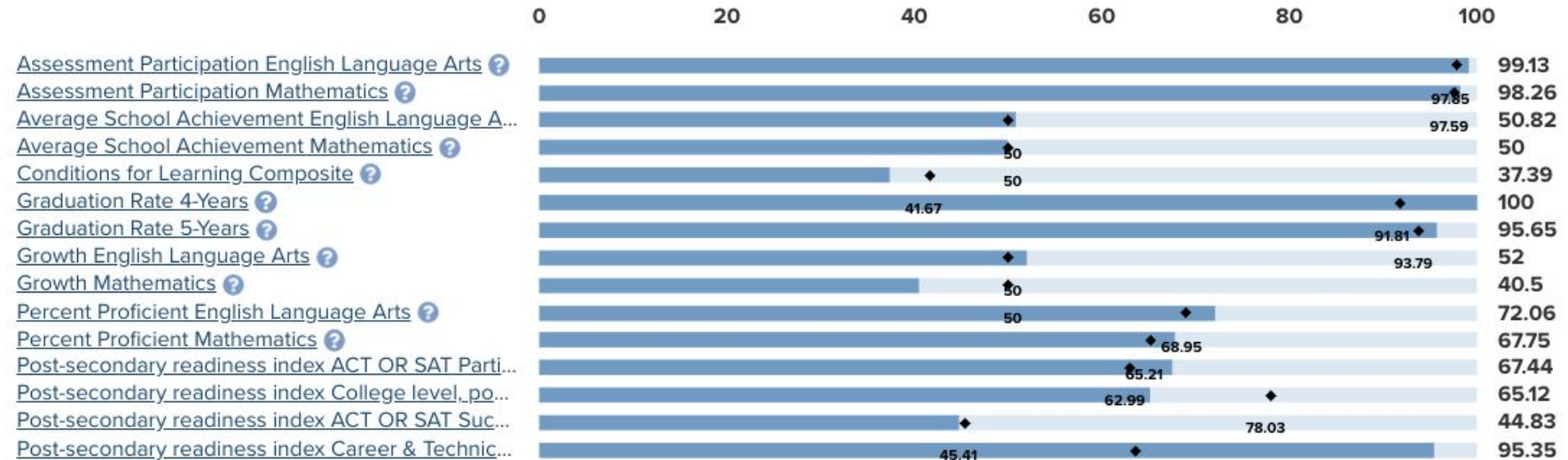

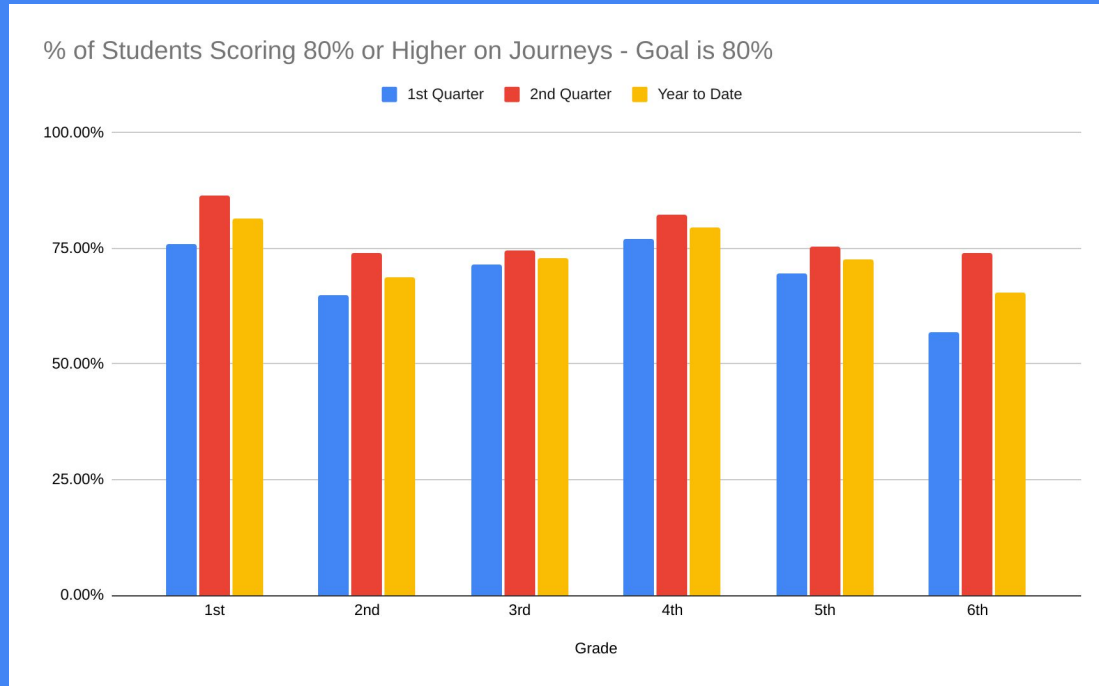

1. 80% of students will achieve 80% or higher on the weekly Journeys (literacy) assessments.

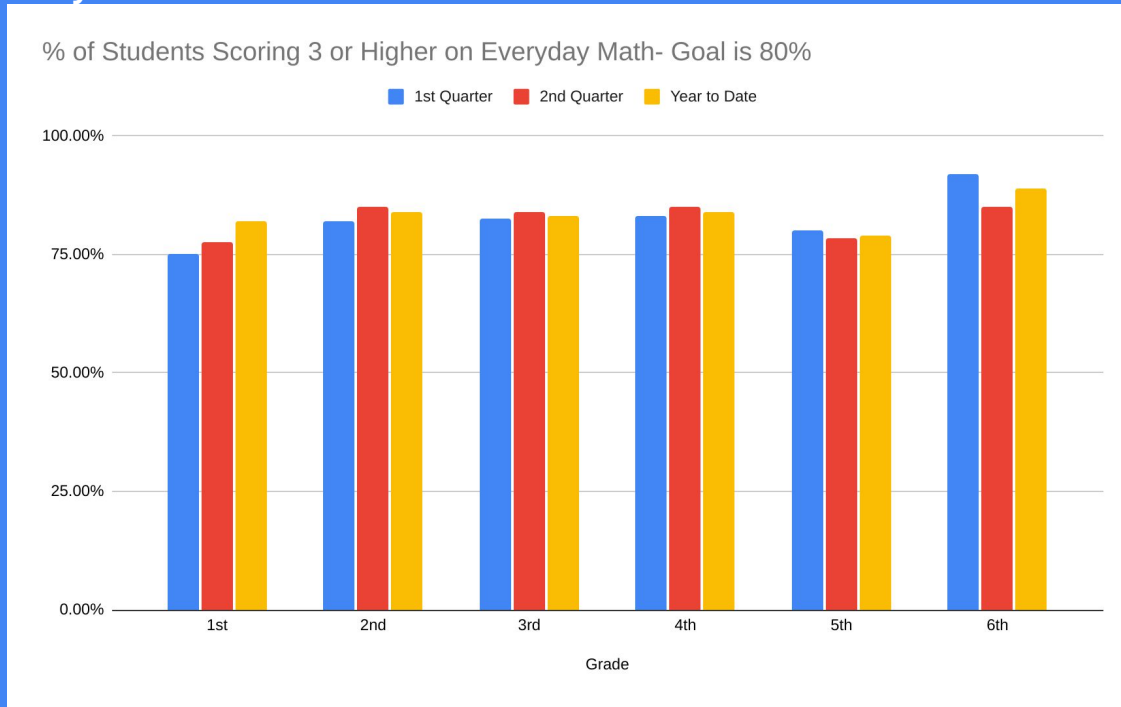




Elementary and Secondary Building Goals Update

Elementary and Secondary Building Goals Update

Secondary Building Goals - Mr. Moser

1. Reduce the number of student missing assignments (MIs)
2. 80% of students will score 80% or higher on post assessments and projects (all academic areas).



2020-2021 Student Achievement - Key Takeaways

Strengths

- MStM is above the state average in 11 out of 15 measures
- MStM has a very high assessment participation rate
- MStM has a 100% 4-year graduation rate
- MStM has 95.35% post-secondary readiness in career and technical education



2020-2021 Student Achievement - Key Takeaways

Opportunities for Improvement

- Secondary Math scores are below the state average, 58.12% proficiency
- Elementary and Secondary ELA is above the state average, but below our goal of 80%
- MStM's Conditions for Learning Survey results are significantly below the state average in both buildings
- MStM's ACT and SAT success and College Level, Post Secondary, or Advanced Coursework is below the state average



School Improvement Focus

For District Goal 1- Student Achievement

- Establish building level student learning goals - complete
- Collect, analyze, and review student learning data frequently (instructional calendar with set dates for assessing, progress monitoring, reviewing progress, making instructional decisions - complete for K-8, 9-12 in progress)
- Implement classwide and small group student interventions for reading and math
 - Elementary
 - 67 students receiving small group reading interventions
 - 59 students receiving small group math interventions
 - Secondary
 - 33 7th and 8th grade students receiving small group reading interventions
 - All 7th and 8th grade students receiving classwide math interventions



School Improvement Focus

For District Goal 1 - Curriculum

- Develop and implement a formal curriculum review framework and adoption cycle - in progress
- Review and adopt literacy curriculum/materials (elementary) and math curriculum/materials (secondary) for 2022-2023 implementation. Provide curriculum/materials PD in 2022-2023
- Review and adopt math curriculum/materials (elementary) and literacy curriculum/materials (secondary) for 2023-2024 implementation. Provide curriculum/materials PD in 2023-2024.



School Improvement Focus

For District Goals 1, 2, 3 and 4 - Professional Development

- Develop a formal PD plan with goals and program evaluation - in progress
- Implement the National Institute of Excellence in Teaching (NIET) Iowa Instructional Framework - in progress
- Develop MStM Core Values and integrate into accelerating character education development (NIET ACED pilot) - in progress
- Provide teachers with Google Workspace PD - in progress and 2022-2023



School Improvement Focus

For District Goals 1, 2, 3, and 4 - Professional Development, cont.

- PD book study, *Shake Up Learning: Moving Learning from Static to Dynamic*, to integrate technology with instruction in all classrooms - planned for 2022-2023
- Develop and implement personalized PD model, teacher focus aligned to Iowa Instructional Framework and student learning goals - in progress for 2022-2023
- Develop and implement formal Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) focused on student learning goals - in progress 2022-2023
