



## **Martensdale-St. Marys Names Dr. Kevin Fiene Interim Superintendent**

MARTENSDALE, IOWA — The Martensdale-St. Marys School District has named Dr. Kevin Fiene as the district's interim superintendent for the 2022-23 school year.

Fiene's most recent full-time role was superintendent and curriculum director at Interstate 35 Community School District in Truro, Iowa. There, he planned \$15 million construction projects and remodeling updates and successfully led a \$7 million bond referendum approval with 86.5 percent.

Fiene retired in 2018 after 39 years of service in education, but currently works part-time at Grundmeyer Leader Services as a consultant, assisting school districts in finding and hiring leadership positions. He also serves as a consultant with Results Group, LLC, working with schools and other non-profit organizations on several index assessments.

Over the course of his career, Fiene has served as an associate professor of education and education department chair, superintendent, principal, secondary principal, and high school social studies teacher. In addition, Fiene was involved in a number of professional and community organizations until his retirement, and he continues to present at education conferences across the country.

Fiene holds an Ed. D. in educational leadership and a master of arts in education degree in educational administration, both from University of Northern Iowa. He received a bachelor's degree in behavioral science from Central College.

The Board of Education has been working with [Grundmeyer Leader Services](#) to conduct the interim superintendent search. Fiene will begin serving as interim superintendent of the Martensdale-St. Marys School District effective the week of October 3<sup>rd</sup>.
