MARTENSDALE, IOWA — The Martensdale-St. Marys Community School District has named Joshua Jacobs as the district's new business manager.

Jacobs has 17 years of educational experience in operations, team leadership, technology, and project management within the Urbandale Community School District. His most recent role was community education coordinator, through which he was responsible for recruiting, selecting, and training staff and scheduling volunteers and part-time employees. He also coordinated all in-district and out-of-district facility scheduling and rentals, generating \$100,000 in annual revenue.

In addition, Jacobs has served as associate athletic director, assistant athletic director for game operations, and activities assistant in Urbandale. These roles have provided Jacobs with firsthand experience in budget planning, facility management, and program development.

Jacobs holds a bachelor's degree in health and human performance with an emphasis in sports management from Iowa State University. He received his activities administration authorization from the Iowa Board of Educational Examiners, and he is currently obtaining an initial school business officer authorization.
